



This workshop offers a hands-on introduction to the minor in Textual Studies and Digital Humanities:

- explore the riches of UW Libraries and Tateuchi East Asia Library Special Collections from early manuscripts, historical printed books and maps to artists' books
- try letterpress printing and book arts (print and make a small book). Write a letter on a typewriter (and mail it!)
- discover techniques and challenges of digitization
- experiment creatively with computational technologies, from NLP to AI

Sessions led by UW faculty, librarians, and by local printers and book artists. Combine in later quarter with TXTDS 201 for 5 cr of elective credit towards the TXTDS minor.
