The Martin Family Foundation partners with UW to offer financial awards to Washington community college students and graduates interested in eventually obtaining bachelors' degrees from the University of Washington in Seattle.

If you are considering an application to UW, you may qualify for one of the following:

MARTIN ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION OPEN FEBRUARY-APRIL EACH YEAR

- The Martin Achievement opportunity is designed to encourage and assist students early in their community college careers to pursue their baccalaureate at UW Seattle after completing their associate's degrees or transfer requirements.
- Applicants for the 2026 Martin Achievement Scholarship should have one more year of full-time community college studies remaining before transfer (transfer summer 2027 or later). Apply a year in advance of expected transfer.
- Martin Achievement Scholars receive \$5,000 in support for their final year in community college and up to \$12,000 per year for up to three years of undergraduate studies at UW Seattle.

MARTIN HONORS SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION OPEN MAY-JULY EACH YEAR

- The Martin Honors opportunity enables community college students of exceptional ability and outstanding achievements to complete their baccalaureate degrees at UW Seattle. Students are expected to have well-formulated ideas about the direction of future studies and subsequent careers.
- Applicants for the 2026 Martin Honors Scholarship should plan to transfer to UW Seattle in summer 2026, fall 2026, or winter 2027.
- Martin Family Honors Scholars receive up to \$12,000 per year for up to three years of undergraduate studies at UW Seattle.

2026 ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be:

- WA residents who are either U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or eligible for in-state tuition through HB 1079 or DACA standards qualification.
- Currently enrolled students at a WA community college pursuing their first baccalaureate degree, with one more academic year of full-time enrollment remaining during 2026-27 at their community college before transferring to UW in Seattle. Applicants for the 2026 Martin Achievement Scholarship should not plan to transfer to the UW Seattle prior to the summer 2027.
- Have earned a minimum of 15 WA community college transfer credits by the scholarship application deadline.
- Have demonstrated signs of exceptional ability in science, engineering, humanities, music, art (all academic fields are supported), and/or leadership.
- The award will depend on successful admission to UW Seattle as a matriculated student.
- Running Start students are not eligible to apply for this scholarship but can apply for the Martin Honors Scholarship.

2026 HONORS SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be:

- WA residents who are either U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or eligible for in-state tuition through HB 1079 or DACA standards qualification.
- Currently attending or have attended a community college in WA and plan to transfer to UW Seattle spring 2026 (if fewer than 18 UW credits earned by July 2026), summer 2026, fall 2026, or winter 2027.
- Have earned a minimum of 36 credits at a WA community college by the time they matriculate at UW Seattle. Students who hold an associate's degree are encouraged to apply.
- WA community college transfer students who are currently enrolled at UW may not have earned more than 18 UW credits by the application deadline.
- The award will depend on successful admission to UW Seattle as a matriculated student.

INTERVIEWS

ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP: MAY 2026

- After the internal UW selection committee reviews all applications, a select number of applicants will be invited to interview with the Martin Family Foundation Board. After those interviews, final selection decisions will be made and all applicants will be notified.

HONORS SCHOLARSHIP: SEPTEMBER 2026
